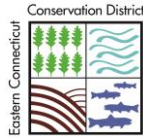

Woodstock Academy is located at 57 Academy Road, Woodstock, CT



- A – Woodstock Academy Commons (dining hall)
- B – Main Woodstock Academy Parking Lot
- C – Overflow Parking behind the Evangelical Free Church

From 395 S take exit 47 (formerly exit 97) in Putnam
Turn right at the end of the exit ramp onto Route 44
1.0 Mile - Turn right onto Route 171 (by Owen Tarr Field)
3.6 Miles, remain straight on Route 169 (at traffic light).
1.1 Miles, turn right onto Academy Road.
The main parking lot entrance will be on your right

From 395 N take exit 45 (formerly exit 95) in Putnam
Turn right onto Kennedy Drive
1.7 Miles, turn left onto Woodstock Avenue
1.2 Miles, stay straight on Route 171
2.1 Miles, stay straight on Route 169 (at traffic light)
1.1 Miles, turn right onto Academy Road.
The main parking lot entrance will be on your right
